Dallas, the gregarious of the dyad is a Reiki master who uses Sasquatch calls into the wild and claims to have a sheeps bone in his skull; Some claim Dallas to be one of the world's leading big foot researchers. Wayne, is the repressed, emotional of the gang- a former high-school bully who currently works at a car wash and is living paycheck to paycheck.
